Day 1 – Thursday 2

(D) PRAGUE - 1 night Day 2 - Friday 3

• The tour starts today from your hotel in



PRAGUE. Begin your afternoon with a walking tour to Old Town Square, enclosed by Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, Rococo-style buildings before viewing Týn Church and its magnificent towers, the unique Astronomical Clock, St. Nicholas Cathedral, and Old Town Hall. Continue to the 14th-century

Charles Bridge, one of Prague's loveliest and most characteristic sights with its 16 arches and 30 statues. Join your fellow travelers for a WELCOME DINNER in the local restaurant tonight.

Day 3 and 4 - Saturday 4 + Sunday 5 (B, L) PILSEN - 3 nights

• AM, free time. • PM, depart to **PLZEŇ** to celebrate



with locals the Pilsen Liberation Festival - the 79th Anniversary of the end of WW II and the liberation of Pilsen by the United States 3rd Army in

1945. The main events will include the memorial services to the U.S. veterans of the 16th Armored

Division, the 2nd and 97th Infantry Divisions, and the Belgian veterans of the 17th Fusilier Battalion. The Convov of Liberty will conclude the Pilsen festival. Detail program will be announced by the end



of March 2024.

Day 5 - Monday 6 (B. L)

• Day trip to the most famous Bohemian spa town of KARLOVY VARY. It was named after the



Bohemian king and Holy Roman Emperor Charles IV who allegedly found the springs in 1358 during a hunting expedition. In 19th century. the royalty came here from

all over Europe for treatment. Among the rich and famous who visited Karlsbad are Goethe, Schiller, Beethoven, and Chopin. The town is replete with ornate Art Nouveau spa houses, cafes, restaurants, shops, and scenic promenades. A guided tour of the city will take us to the colonnade with 12 hot springs.

• After lunch we'll continue to MARIANSKÉ

LÁZNĚ - the second largest spa resort in the Czech Republic founded in the last century. Carefully arranged large parks, spa forests, specific architecture, and flourishing cultural and social life. Of the 140 mineral springs in the town, 39 are used for treating kidneys, respiratory and



urinary disorders. Tour the Colonnade and view the "Singing Fountain" in front of the main colonnade. Free time at leisure. Later PM return to PILSEN.

Day 6 - Tuesday 7 (B, L) ČESKÉ BUDĚJOVICE - 2 nights


• AM, depart to ČESKÉ BUDĚJOVICE - the royal



town founded in 1265. Guided city tour. In the town's city center is a magnificent square, one of the largest in Europe. It is lined with Gothic. Renaissance, and Baroque houses

with arcades. and Fountain in its center. PM visits the original Budweiser Brewery and samples the beer. Rest of the day at leisure.



Day 7 - Wednesday 8 (B. L)

• Day trip to the Medieval town of ČESKÝ



KRUMLOV - the jewel of South Bohemia, a UNESCO World Heritage Site universally recognized as a unique remnant of historic urbanism. The old town preserves, virtually intact and still vital, an unparalleled ensemble of Gothic,

Renaissance. and Baroque structures. Among the attractions is the second-largest castle complex in the Czech Republic. Guided city tour followed by free time for leisure/shopping of beautiful



Bohemian Garnets or a chance to visit the chateau or further explore the town.

Day 8 - Thursday 9 (B, L) BRNO – 3 nights



Before Noon depart to **TELČ**. The town consists of a long square lined with arcades and the church of St. James from

the 14th

century. The Chateau complex is the most impressive architecture in the region. Free time/lunch. • PM continues to BRNO. Guided city tour includes the Church of St. Jacob, Vegetable Market, and Cathedral of

Ss. Peter & Paul; Spilberg Castle area, city center, and more.

Day 9 - Friday 10 B, L)

• AM, depart BRNO to **KROMĚŘÍŽ**. In 1777, this



town in Central Moravia became the seat of the bishops of Olomouc. The splendid Kroměříž chateau and its beautiful gardens are considered an especially attractive and well-preserved example

of Baroque palatial and garden design. Guided city tour and Chateau, including adjoining colonnade and beautiful gardens.

• AM, free time at leisure. • PM departs for OLOMOUC. The second largest city after Prague, in the period 1187-1641, was the capital of Moravia. The residence of bishops since 1063, the first

archbishop



installed in 1777. The most significant are the Cathedral of St. Wenceslas from 1109 and the Holy Trinity Column from 1716-1754. Guided city tour. Later PM return to BRNO.

Day 11 - Sunday 12 (B, D) Prague – 2 nights
