Here we will have time to view the memorial before continuing over to Omaha Beach & Pointe du Hoc. On arrival at Omaha beach we will have time to reflect on the bloody slaughter of many young Americans that died here. After visiting Omaha beach we will climb the bluffs to overlook the beachhead area and visit St. Laurent-sur-Mer American Military Cemetery.

Tuesday 28 ORLEANS- 1 night

AM depart Caen to ORLEANS. On the way we'll



make a short stop in LE MANS and then continue to visit the Chateau Amboise.
