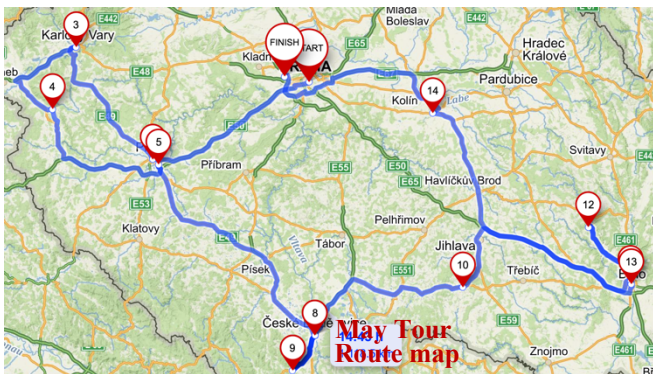

Tuesday, May 3



Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Wednesday 4 (D) PRAGUE – 1 night

The **tour starts today from your hotel in PRAGUE.** Begin your afternoon with a walking tour to Old Town Square, enclosed by Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque and Rococo style buildings before viewing Týn Church and its magnificent towers, the unique Astronomical Clock, St. Nicholas Cathedral and Old Town Hall. Continue to the 14th century Charles Bridge, one of Prague's loveliest and most characteristic sights with its 16 arches and 30 statues. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a **WELCOME DINNER** in the local restaurant.

Thursday 5 – Monday 9 (B, L) PILSEN – 4 nights

After breakfast depart to **Pilsen.**

Monday 9 (B, L)

Day trip to the most famous Bohemian spa town of **KARLOVY VARY**. It was named for the Bohemian king and Holy Roman Emperor Charles IV who allegedly found the springs in 1358 during a hunting expedition. In the 19th century, royalty came here from all over Europe for treatment. Among the rich and famous who visited Karlsbad are Goethe, Schiller, Beethoven and Chopin. The town is replete with ornate Art Nouveau spa houses, cafes, restaurant, shops and scenic promenades. Guided tour of the city will take us to the colonnade with 12 hot springs. After lunch we'll continue to **MARIÁNSKÉ LÁZNĚ** - the second largest spa resort in the Czech Republic founded in the last century. Carefully arranged large parks, spa forests, specific architecture, flourishing cultural and social life. Of the 140 mineral springs in the town, 39 are used for treating kidneys, respiratory and urinary disorders. Tour the Colonnade and view the "Singing fountain" in front of the main colonnade. Free time at leisure. Later PM return to Pilsen.



Tuesday 10 (B, L) České Budějovice – 2 nights

AM depart to **ČESKÉ BUDĚJOVICE** - the royal town founded in 1265. Guided city tour. In the city center of the town is a magnificent square, one of the largest in Europe. It is lined with Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque houses with arcades, Samson's Fountain in its center. PM visit the original Budweiser Brewery, sample the beer. Rest of the day at leisure.

Wednesday 11 (B, L)

Day trip to **ČESKÝ KRUMLOV** - the jewel of South Bohemia is a UNESCO World Heritage Site universally recognized as a unique remnant of historic urbanism. The old town preserves, virtually intact and still vital, an unparalleled ensemble of Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque structures. Among the attractions is the second largest castle complex in the Czech Republic. Guided city tour followed by free time for shopping of Bohemian Garnets in the factory store, other souvenirs or a chance to visit the chateau.

Thursday 12 (B, L) Brno – 2 nights

Before Noon depart to **TELČ**. The town consist of a long square lined with arcades and church of St. James from the 14th century. Chateau complex is the most impressive architecture of the region. Free time / lunch. PM continue to **BRNO**. Guided city tour includes: Church of St. Jacob, Vegetable market, Cathedral of Ss. Peter & Paul; Spilberg Castle area, city center and more.

Friday 13 (B, L)

After breakfast we'll depart to visit one of the most beautiful and exceptionally best preserved castles in the Bohemian-Moravian Highlands for almost eight centuries now - the **PERNŠTEJN CASTLE**. It was founded in the last quarter of the 13th century. The



castle is set out to learn about the story of this magnificent seat of the Pernštejn family - walk its chambers, climb the fairytale tower and you may even meet the local White Lady. Walking on narrow, spiraling staircases, gazing up at vaulted ceilings and visiting the Baroque chapel will take you on an unforgettable journey to periods past. Pernštejn is not only a leading Czech monument, but thanks to its magnificence, also a place used by film crews from all over the world.

Saturday 14 (B, D)

AM depart to **KUTNÁ HORA**. We'll tour the St. Barbara Cathedral and city center. After lunch time we'll transfer to Prague. **WALK THROUGH PRAGUE'S ROYAL ROAD**. Today we will follow in the footsteps of kings along this 400 year-old route, and view what their royal eyes looked upon. Part of the tour will include Republic Square - it lies at the boundary of Old Town and New Town and is the intersection of eight roads. 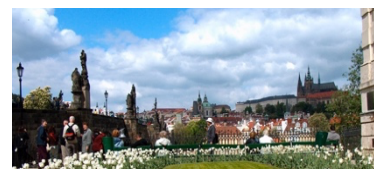

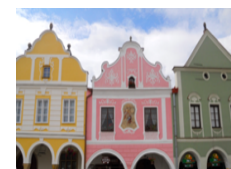
